

Worship Guidelines during COVID-19

Masks are not required, but are recommended and requested. We have masks available if you need one.

There will be two tables located in fellowship hall, one at each entry. Pick up your bulletin, communion, and masks from these tables before going into the sanctuary. Hand sanitizer is also available on these tables.

You may leave your offering in the offering plate located on the tables as you come in, or when you leave.

There will be a wastebasket outside the sanctuary for your communion cup.

Fellowship hour has been suspended during this COVID-19 time.

The nursery will not be available during this time.

Socializing after church should be done on your own outside the church building.

Families who live together are allowed to sit in the same pew.

Couples are allowed to sit together with one couple at each end of the pew.

Singles should sit three to a pew, one at each end and one in the middle.

Every third pew is available. The other pews have been marked off.

All books, pencils, and paper have been removed from the pews. Music will be included in your bulletin. This is done because these things cannot be sanitized and should not be shared during this time.
